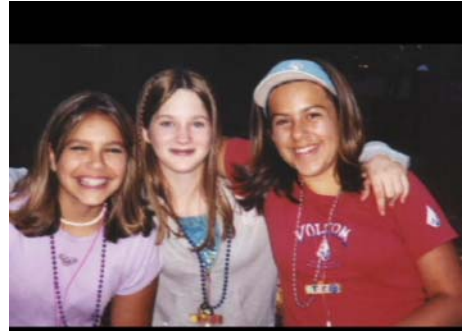


Camp Counselor @ Camp McCumber



Under the direction of the Camp Director, the Volunteer YMCA Resident Camp Counselor @ Camp McCumber is responsible for implementing the daily schedule as it relates to the campers, their cabin and camp activities. YMCA Resident Camp @ Camp McCumber offers counselors, counselors in training and children an outdoor environment which is happy, safe and educational; a place where they will learn respect for their fellow campers, for their own abilities, and for the natural beauty of the area.

Requirements:

1. Be at least 18 years of age;
2. Have a high school diploma or its equivalent;
3. Complete the Live Scan/Finger Print criminal record clearance and provide a receipt or proof of completion of Live Scan;
4. Complete and submit a Volunteer Application;
5. Have experience working with children, preferably in an organized setting.

Responsibilities:

1. Supervise play and game activities of campers;
2. Maintain discipline and order;
3. Responsible for the cleanliness of camp;
4. Display a positive attitude that is conducive to good public relations;
5. Supervise the health and safety of all campers.

Volunteer Resident Camp Counselors assist in implementing a stimulating program for all participants while providing a healthy and safe environment. They should have a general understanding of the goals and objectives of the Shasta Family YMCA and demonstrate the YMCA four core values: Caring, Honesty, Respect, and responsibility during their everyday work schedule.
