Dear Y Club Parents and Guardians,

We are truly honored to have more than 125 youth participating in Y Club each day. It is a privilege to provide a welcoming space where young people can work out, enjoy a free after-school meal, complete homework, socialize with friends, and simply be themselves. Seeing our youth play, connect, and thrive in this environment is the reason we do what we do.

As a reminder, Y Club access is free with membership and is not licensed childcare. The Y does not monitor when or if your student arrives at or leaves our facilities. While our staff do their best to supervise and engage youth while they are at Y Club, it is not a structured childcare program and attendance is not tracked.

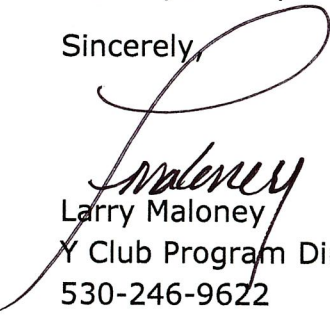
If families would like their youth to be formally checked in and checked out by staff, we do offer a structured program option for a program fee of \$125 for Facility members and \$240 for Community members a month. Please contact me if you would like more information about this option.

Several times throughout the year, we will send reminders like this one asking all parents and guardians to review our [Membership Policies, Code of Conduct and Y Club Policy & Guidelines for 12 and Under](#) with their student. Your partnership in reinforcing expectations helps us maintain a safe, respectful, and positive environment for everyone.

Additionally, please remind students who are 12 years old and under that they are not permitted in the main facility without an adult guardian present. They must stay in Y South where Y Club is held. Youth 13 years and older are welcome in the main facility where there is less supervision, assuming they are following our code of conduct.

Thank you for your continued support. We are grateful to be part of their journey.
